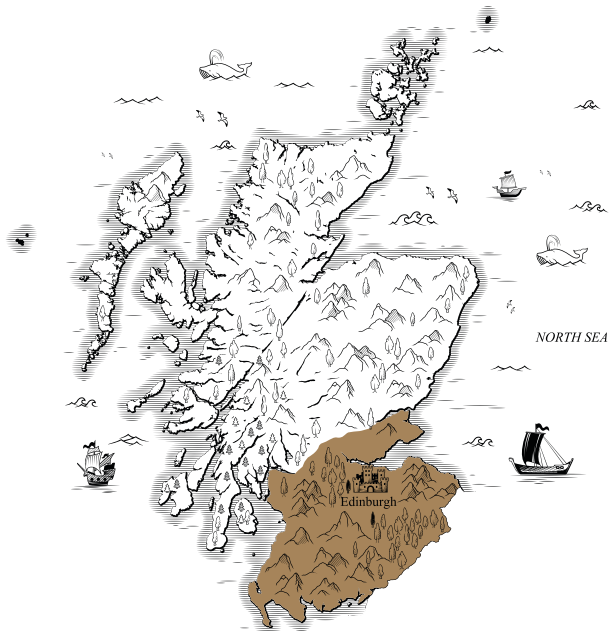

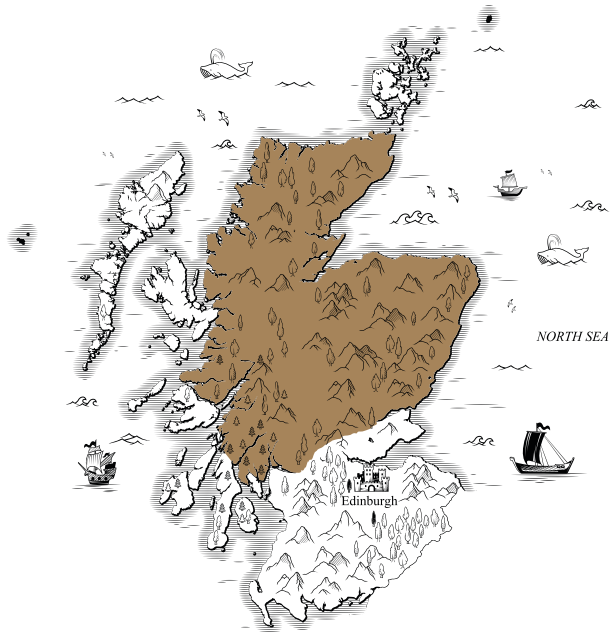

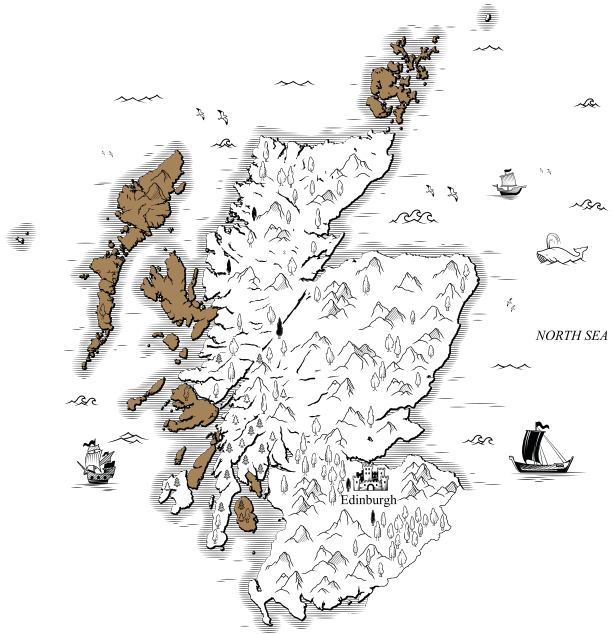

*The most northerly distillery in the world situated in Arctic Norway produces some unique small batch single malts. Co-founded by a Scot in 2013 it is a fusion of traditional and modern experimental distilling. The 9 worlds of Norse Mythology series was launched in 2020 and has become a highly collectable series worldwide. Prestonfield is unique in being able to offer the complete range to their guests. The whole series is non-chill filtered and of natural colour.*



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## BIVROST NINE WORLDS

<b>Bivrost Niflheim</b>		46%	45

*Niflheim (“world of fog”) is one of the Nine Worlds of Norse mythology and the homeland of darkness, cold, mist, and ice which is very similar to our Arctic Winter. Matured in sherry seasoned casks, Bourbon casks and virgin oak this single malt has lots of deliciously juicy dried fruits and sweet toasted nuts. Dried cherries, sultanas, raisins, figs. Then sweet caramelised peanuts, almonds and hazelnuts with a hint of black pepper. A lovely balance of sweet and woody spice with hints of dried fruit. Long and sweet finish with hints of spice.*

<b>Bivrost Nidavellir</b>		46%	25
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*Nidavellir is described as a dark place with golden halls. Nidavellir is matured in predominantly bourbon quarter casks, finished in some special casks from a famous Islay distillery. The casks used for finishing the Nidavellir are French Oak casks which were initially used by a renowned winery in New Zealand to mature their Pinot Noir. These casks were then purchased by an Islay distillery for a limited edition, they were charred and scored inside to release more flavours. Initially a real burst of fresh vanilla pod and bakewell tart with rich maraschino cherries. Soft and sweet smoke mingles with dark chocolate, poached pears and black pepper notes. Long and lingering finish with sweet smoke, almonds and maraschino cherries.*

<b>Bivrost Jotunheim</b>		46%	25
<i>Jotunheim is the world of giants - or Jotnar as they are named in ancient Norse mythology. Jotunheim consists mostly of rocks, wilderness, and dense forests, and it lies in the snowy regions on the outermost shores of the ocean. Jotunheim is matured in predominantly bourbon quarter casks and finished in some Ex Stout Beer Casks from a micro-brewery. These were previously Nidavellir casks. Caramel and mocha aroma with hints of dark roasted coffee, vanilla chocolate and tobacco sweet rich and full bodied style, slowly unwrapping layers of complexity.</i>			
<b>Bivrost Muspelheim</b>		46%	25
<i>Muspelheim has been described as a hot and glowing land of fire, home to the fire giants and guarded by the jotunn Surtr with his flaming sword. A smokey blend of Scottish peated malt and Arctic malt. The casks used for this “world” were ex Islay barrels (200 l), ex Bourbon quarter casks and some smaller Octave casks. On the nose there are classic Bourbon and American oak characteristics, definitely a sweet aroma of vanilla but also a fruity base coming from the spirit giving additional pear and apple spice. On the palate, the peat bursts through, not too subtle but not overpowering either, just a perfect balance of smoke and the sweetness mellows everything down, smooth with a lingering finish that goes on and on.</i>

<b>Bivrost Helheim</b>	46%	25
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*Far down beneath the roots of Yggdrasil, lies the fearful domain of Hel, the goddess of death. She is the daughter of Loki and Angerboda and rules over those not worthy of reaching Asgard. Helheim is matured in crocodile charred Bourbon casks, and ex-Islay casks. Mouth-filling texture, with a clear barrel presence, spices, rounded with caramel and a gentle, smoky after taste. Clean nose with a strong oak presence, some biscuits and spices with gentle vanilla and the Islay peat coming through.*

<b>Bivrost Vanaheim</b>		46%	25
<i>Vanaheim is the home of the Vanir, a group of gods associated with fertility, wisdom, and the ability to see the future. Vanaheim is matured ex-Bourbon casks and then finished in Teak casks. Teak cask finishing is extremely rare, it imparts some very interesting notes into the maturation process. The combination of casks produces elements of vanilla and tropical fruits, with a clear influence of cinnamon and other spices. There is a liquid marzipan aroma and taste with almond and honey coming through. A distinctive dessert or festive whisky and perhaps a challenging moment, the aroma and taste only comes from the Teak, this is a very rare and experimental whisky.</i>			
<b>Bivrost Alfheim</b>		46%	25
<i>Alfheim was the land of the Elves, in Norse mythology. In this world you would find both Ljósálfar, “Light Elves, and Dökkálfar, “Dark Elves.” Alfheim was matured in different virgin oak casks, built from various oak types from around the world. The oak types are French oak, American oak, Chinquapin (Californian) oak and Colombian oak. Raisins, sultanas, nutmeg, cinnamon, wood and caramel. Very rich, oriental spices, cloves and classic vanilla, honey and coconut flavours bring a delicious finish.</i>

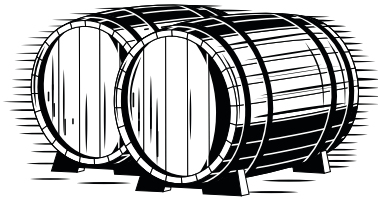
*In Norse mythology, Midgard is the realm where humanity resides, nestled between the domains of the Aesir and the giants. The name itself signifies a sheltered or safeguarded area at the heart of creation. Midgard was matured in different Oloroso Sherry seasoned oak casks, predominantly European oak, some American oak for complexity and also Spanish oak was involved. Oriental spices, clove and vanilla with dried fruits and some sandal wood. Massive body, oily and long finish, with a hint of oak and dried fruits. A complex and classic Single Malt Whisky.*

<i>Roal Brackla distillery on the Cawdor estate in the highlands. The distillery has been producing whisky for over 200 years. In November 2020 Alpha released, from lock-down, a single cask of 12 year old Royal Brackla. This unique whisky has fully matured since April 2008 in a first-fill Spanish Oloroso sherry hogshead.</i>			
<b>Alpha Two</b>	13	55.9%	14
<i>13 year old Croftengea, distilled at Loch Lomond distillery. This malt is the distillery's most peated spirit, typically used to blend. In November 2020, the Alpha Croftengea was released, having been fully matured in a first fill Portuguese Madeira cask.</i>			
<b>Alpha Three</b>	12	56.3%	14
<i>The Alpha Deanston was released in December 2021, having been fully matured in a first-fill bourbon barrel, since September 2009. The result is a beautiful golden spirit with soft, fresh taste with a super-smooth finish.</i>			
<b>Alpha Fore</b>	15	53.8%	14
<i>150 bottles of the Alpha Inchfad, matured since 2007 in an American oak bourbon cask were released in July 2022, the day before the 150th open championship at St.Andrews. The Loch Lomond distilled spirit has a golf heritage and is best undiluted to appreciate the bold whisky at a cask-strength.</i>

<i>The distillery has been producing whisky for over 200 years and was the first whisky to be granted the Royal Warrant in 1833. The whisky matured in a American oak, Bourbon cask from March 2011 before being finished in a Oloroso Sherry cask for over two years before being bottled in 2023.</i>			
<b>Alpha Six</b>	12	58.8%	14
<i>Six release was distilled at the Auchroisk Distillery in Banffshire in Speyside. Production started in 1974. This whisky distilled on the 21st December 2010, a remarkable day which witnessed a full lunar eclipse coinciding with the winter solstice. The whisky has matured in a first fill Oloroso Sherry cask for over 12 years</i>			
<b>Alpha Seven</b>	11	59.9%	14
<i>Balmenach Distillery in Cromdale on the banks of the River Spey. The Distillery is one of the oldest Speyside distilleries, founded in 1824. The whisky has been matured for a total of over 11 years, 10 years in an American oak refill Bourbon cask, then finished for over 20 months in a Chateau Leoville, Bordeaux red wine barrel. This strong single malt is bottled at cask- strength with an out-turn of only 250 bottles.</i>
